Iran does not fear embargo - diplomat

Iran does not fear any embargo that might be imposed on it over its nuclear program, Iranian Ambassador to Azerbaijan Afshar Suleymani has said. "There is nothing new for us in the imposition of an embargo on us: the U.S. imposed an embargo on Iran a long time ago, and all our development, especially regarding the nuclear program, fell exactly on the embargo period," Suleymani told journalists on Friday. Progress that Iran made in the development of the defense area, the military-industrial complex, nanotechnology, biotechnology, and the nuclear program coincided with the embargo period, Suleymani said.
